EXPENSES:

Competitors and all other Team Members are responsible for their own travel, accommodation and meal expenses.

PARTICIPANTS' DOCUMENTS:

Each Russian participant must submit to the mandate commission a copy and original of:

- health insurance which covers sport risks and traumas;
- passport/birth certificate which proves the age.

AWARDS:

The top three competitors in each event (Final results) will be honored and awarded by trophies, medals and diplomas.

Others will receive diplomas and memory presents.

RESULTS:

Judging and calculations will be done according to ISU Special Regulations and Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating and Ice Dance 2018. Result information and detailed protocols will be available on the website www.MatryoshkaCup.com

(+/- 10 sec.)</p> <p>Elements:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">– 1W: jump from two legs and landing on two legs without revolution.– Usp: pivot position.– ChSq (mandatory sequence of the following elements): Basic Stroking + 3 Swizzles + “Sledge sliding” (sliding in a straight line on two maximally bent legs, hands in front of you) + “Heron” on any leg (sliding in a straight line on one leg, the free leg is bent at the knee joint, the skating boot of the free leg is pressed to the knee of the support one). <p>All three elements are judged (ChSq, 1W, Usp)</p> <p>Program Components are only judged in</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">– Skating Skills– Performance / execution <p>It is permitted for coach to be on the ice with a skater during the program.</p> <p>There is no deduction for fall.
